

So far, we have learnt about If clauses Type 0 and Type 1.

Let's repeat:

Type 0 is used when we talk about habits, give advice, speak about general truths and facts.

Type 1 is used when talking about a possible condition and a probable result.


| vrsta Type | pogojni stavek If Clause (condition) | glavni stavek Main Clause |
|---------------|--|-------------------------------------|
| Type 0 | If + Present Simple (osebek + glagol) | Present Simple (osebek + glagol) |
| Type 1 | If + Present Simple (osebek + glagol) | Will Future (osebek + glagol) |
